

How Can I Purchase Daylilies From Your Nursery ???

*** In an earlier post we covered how to plan a visit to enjoy our Display Garden, in this post we will cover how to go about purchasing plants from our Nursery.

*** **There are two ways** to select and purchase daylilies for your garden, landscape, or as a gift. **First is to view our 2021 Catalog Images found on our main Facebook Page** (https://www.facebook.com/Lasting-Dreams-Daylilies-205091862872389/photos/?tab=album&ref=page_internal) and from there you can select from among the cultivars we grow to see what catches your eye.

*** **Next step is to go to our website** (www.LastingDreamsDaylilies.com) and either view or download our current catalog. If you already have a daylily cultivar in mind that you would like to purchase, the pricing will be listed, and if marked as display, contact us as to availability and price. Now if you have been looking through the images, the catalog will not only provide pricing, but complete specifications about a particular daylily.

*** **Finally just simply download an order form from the website**, and either mail or email a copy to us, or simply call us and we can take your order and payment over the phone. When ordering, you have a choice of picking up your selections here at the nursery, or we can ship them directly to you. For pickups we will schedule a day and time, and sales tax will be added to your order. For shipping, our rate schedule is on the order form, and we suggest ordering early (before the scapes start maturing) or later in the season (when the plant is finished blooming for the season); we hate to cut back scapes, but often in mid- season it's necessary to allow for affordable shipping.

*** We are working toward developing a shopping cart system for our website, which in the future will allow for a quicker and easier process for ordering.

*** **The second way is to schedule a visit**, and select from the beds of daylilies themselves. The advantage to this is that you have the opportunity to view the entire plant, and because there is no need to trim anything back, you'll enjoy all the remaining bloom on that cultivar for the remainder of the season.

*** **In most instances, we will take and process your order for pickup on a later day**; this often proves to be advantageous to our customers, as they often need to prepare the spots for their new selections; better for us to have them fresh dug on the day of pickup, rather than sitting in a bucket of water.

*** We do however have **customers who travel long distances**, for what is often their yearly return visit to add to their collection. In these circumstances, we will insure that when scheduling, there is an ample amount of time devoted to that visit, including **processing and digging their order to take back home with them.**

*** However, there are occasions where someone visits, with no intent to purchase, but gets swept up into the beauty surrounding them, and wants to bring one or more daylilies home. In those instances,

we will work to accommodate that individual, which may mean digging while they wait, or coming back later in the day; we are very flexible, and always strive to have everyone leaving happy.
