

How Can I Visit Your Display Garden...

We host ***Garden Visitors***, as well as ***Nursery Customers***, and you may fall into either or both categories, but we do make a distinction. We are not a public facility, our “***Display Garden***” is ***Private***, shared with invited guests, and we do have guidelines that we ask those guests to abide by, while touring our extensive garden collection; those are posted onsite, and available upon request.

For the past 17 years our Display Garden has evolved to where we currently feature over **2000 AHS Registered Cultivars**, plus **Hundreds of Seedlings** (daylilies under evaluation or unregistered), with most of those a product of our own Hybridizing Program.

Together with the welcoming design of the grounds, we are known as a destination garden, drawing Regional Visitors, including travelers Nationwide and international. We have hosted individual tour groups and convention attendees, and we continue that opportunity for organizations and groups by prior arrangement; have your group leader/tour operator contact us for details, keeping in mind that July is Peak Bloom Season, and openings can fill quickly.

If you connect to us through Facebook, are a Customer or Previous Visitor, or received one of our Gift Certificates or Event Postcards, ***you are automatically extended an invitation to visit, just contact us to schedule a date & time***; all others need to contact us to ***request*** a visit.

We will also continue to host a series of “***Special Events***”, to allow for those who cannot commit to a scheduled time; and for 2023 we have 5 planned thus far.

We will be hosting three “***Sunday In The Garden – Open Gardens***” all on **Sundays** from **Noon till 5 PM**; **July 9th**, **July 23rd**, & **August 6th**.

Additionally we will be repeating our popular “***Evening In The Garden***” events, and those will also be on **Sundays** from **7 PM till 9 PM**; **July 16th** & **July 30th**: so mark your calendars.
