

Since 1849, the name “Lord & Burnham” was synonymous with legendary Conservatories and Greenhouse Structures, located throughout the United States.

For 139 years, this company founded in nearby Buffalo, New York, designed and created some of the most noteworthy structures dedicated to horticulture, and we are fortunate to have one of those treasures to enjoy, less than 10 miles away.

The Buffalo and Erie County Botanical Gardens is comprised of what was known as the “South Park Conservatory”, completed in 1899, and is one of only two triple dome examples in the nation. This continues to be a crowning jewel of the Buffalo Olmstead Parks System, which itself was designed by Fredrick Law Olmstead, Sr. and Calvert Vaux, and completed in 1876; today 850 acres of that original design is preserved as parkland.

For us growing up in Lackawanna, New York, it was constant feature we always enjoyed, as it was just a few blocks away. For generations, walking to visit with younger siblings in tow, was never an issue, and in the 50’s and 60’ it was no different; it wouldn’t be Easter Sunday without enjoying the floral display offered each year.
